- *Part A deductible is only cost for up to 60 days of Medicare-covered inpatient hospital care. For extended hospital stays, beneficiaries must pay an additional \$408 per day for days 61 through 90 in 2024, and \$816 per day for hospital stays beyond the 90th day in a benefit period.*
- **Although most beneficiaries will pay up to \$174.70 for Part B in 2024, some premiums will be lower due to a “hold harmless” provision to prevent overall reduction of the Social Security benefit. A small number of beneficiaries — individuals with income exceeding \$103,000 and married couples exceeding \$206,000 — will pay a higher Part B premium based on their income.*
